## School drop off and pick up

It is concerning to see that a lot of our students are getting picked up later and later of an afternoon. As you are aware, school finishes at 2:55pm and there are times that students are here well after 3:30pm. We are not an after school service.

If you are having trouble picking up your child by 2:55pm, then you will need to make arrangements with our OOSH Before and After School Care facility, which runs in the school hall. They can be contacted on (02) 9822 9523 or 0439 937 309.

The beginning and end of the school day are busy times for pedestrians and drivers outside schools. Given this is the beginning of our school year, it is a timely reminder that you can help keep children safe by remembering the following:

- if you need to get out of the car to take your child out of a safety seat, you will need to park and walk to school to ensure that the kiss and drop zone flows smoothly
- drop your child off and pick them up on the school side of the road
- never call out to them from across the road - it is very dangerous
- always take extra care in 40km school zones
- follow all parking signs - these help keep your child as safe as possible
- park responsibly even if it means you have to walk further to the school gate
- never double park - it is illegal and puts children at risk
- never do a U-turn or a three point turn outside the school as it puts children at risk of harm
- model safe and considerate pedestrian and driver behaviours to your child
- always give way to pedestrians particularly when entering and leaving driveways.

## Safety and Congestion- School Pick up

To ensure the safety of all students going home at the end of the day, we ask that all students who are getting picked up by their parents/caregivers to sit in their allocated line as soon as the bell goes. Parents, once teachers have escorted your child to the front/back gate to you we ask if you could please keep the thoroughfare around the entry point and pathways of our school clear. This will assist the teaching staff to fulfil their duty of care obligations ensuring that all students arrive home safely. Your assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated.

## New Fixed Equipment

Over the end of year break we had our new fixed equipment installed. The students have been having a great time playing on it and it is a great addition to our school playground.



## Permission Booklets

On Monday 14 February, the permission booklet notes will be going home with your child/ren. Please look over the details in the booklet carefully and update any information that is incorrect. They will be needed to be returned by Friday 18 February. The first class to bring all the booklets back will receive a pizza party.

We welcome information from parents about your child's health. Our school asks for medical information when you enrol your child. It is also important that you let us know if your child's health care needs change or if a new health condition develops. Information about allergies, medical conditions such as asthma and diabetes and other health care related issues (including prior conditions such as medical procedures in the last 12 months) should be provided to the school by parents. Please provide this information in writing to the principal. This will greatly assist our school in planning to support your child's health and wellbeing. Please also remember to notify staff in the school office of any changes to your contact details or to the contact details of other people nominated as emergency contacts.

We appreciate your assistance in this regard and assure you that any information you provide the school will be stored securely and will only be used or disclosed in order to support your son or daughter's health needs or as otherwise required by law.

Also, a note will be going home on Monday 14 February with information on how to download our Skoolbag app. Having this app is very important in order to keep up to date with information that is happening at Edensor Park Public School.
